

COVID-19 CONTAINMENT MEASURES STATEMENT

In compliance with the general regulatory and administrative provisions adopted throughout Italy with regard to the state of epidemiological emergency caused by COVID-19 and in order to contain the spread of the contagion, the French Academy in Rome – Villa Medici hereby announces that it **may prevent access** to those who, in the last 14 days, have tested positive for COVID-19, have come into contact with people who have tested positive for COVID-19 or come from areas at high epidemiological risk or areas where more restrictive measures have been taken to contain COVID-19 contagion.

The French Academy in Rome – Villa Medici also requires those who enter its spaces to **have their body temperature taken**; people with a temperature above 37.5° will be asked to return to their home immediately, inform their GP and provide or confirm their contact details (first name, last name, telephone number, email) for communication to the health authorities. Upon request, these people will be able to wait in an isolated room for the arrival of a trusted person to take them back home.

- to immediately inform the French Academy in Rome – Villa Medici of the presence of any flu symptoms or breathing problems during their stay or visit at the Villa Medici
- to comply with all the provisions of the Authorities and of the French Academy in Rome – Villa Medici when entering the spaces of the Villa Medici (in particular the maintenance of an interpersonal safety distance of at least 1 meter, the use of hand sanitizers, and the correct wearing of the personal protective mask in all enclosed spaces).

PRIVACY POLICY

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of EU Regulation 679/2016 (hereinafter GDPR) on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, and on the free movement of such data, The French Academy in Rome – Villa Medici informs that the personal data acquired with reference to the relationships established will be processed in compliance with the above mentioned legislation.

MEASURES TO CONTAIN THE SPREAD OF COVID-19

With reference to the containment measures useful to fight the COVID-19 epidemic in the cultural places that welcome the public, we inform that:

1) Purpose of Treatment: prevention from COVID-19 contagion, protection of people's health, collaboration with public authorities and, in particular, health authorities.

2) Legal basis: reasons of public interest: implementation of the anti-accounting security protocols pursuant to art. 1, n. 7, letter d) of the Prime Ministerial Decree of 11 March 2020, in particular Shared Protocol 14 March 2020, Protocol 24 April 2020 and subsequent additions and amendments. The processing also responds to the needs provided for in terms of labour law, security and social protection by Article 9, paragraph 2, letter b) of the GDPR. Legal obligation: art. 32 Constitution; art. 2087 Civil Code; Legislative Decree 81/2008 (in particular art. 20).

3) Data subject to treatment: 1. Body temperature detected in real time, without recording or storage. 2. Identification data, telephone number and e-mail address.

4) Consequences in case of refusal to supply data: in case of refusal to detect the temperature or supply data is prohibited access to the spaces of Villa Medici.

5) Access to the data: the data may be known by the personnel expressly authorized to the treatment. The data are not disclosed or communicated to third parties outside the specific regulatory provisions (e.g. in case of request by the Health Authority for the reconstruction of the chain of possible close contacts of a person found positive to COVID-19). The data may be communicated to public authorities. The data are not transferred abroad and no profiling or automated decisions are made.

6) Methods and storage period: identification data are kept until the end of the state of emergency foreseen by the competent public authorities. No recording and/or storage is carried out if the temperature threshold is not exceeded. Retention for a longer period in relation to requests from the public authorities is not affected. Personal data, even particular data, shall be retained for a longer period, within the limits of the statute of limitations of rights, in relation to requirements related to the exercise of the right of defense in case of disputes and requests by public authorities.

7) Exercise of rights: the Data Controller informs you that in the context of the processing of your personal data you, as the Data Subject, may exercise the following rights at any time: - Access (art. 15 of the Regulations) - Correction (art. 16 of the Regulations) - Cancellation (oblivion) (art. 17 of the Regulations) - Limitation of processing (art. 18 of the Regulations). You also have the right to lodge a complaint (art. 77 EU Reg.) to the Guarantor Authority for the Protection of Personal Data if you believe that your data are processed in a manner that does not comply with the legislation in force or to take legal action (art. 79 EU Reg.).
